Our guild lost a dear former member and past President. Carol Butler was a wonderful influence to many of us....she was active in so many activities, especially making comfort quilts. She was always ready to help when needed. Here is the lovely note that her daughter sent:

"It is with sadness that I send this message that my mother Carol Butler has passed away today. My mom was a past president of the guild and found great sister-ship with its members over the 20 years that she was a member. Mom was blessed with great creative talents and her craftsmanship in quilting was highly regarded. Her untold efforts for the guild-setting up the monthly night meeting, chauffeuring guild members up and down the hill at little notice, to the untold hours of kitchen work put in for the Labor Day shows, are a testament to how much the guild and quilting meant to her. Five years ago, when her oldest son died, she moved off the hill and began a new life quilting life in Prescott, Arizona for two years, the moving on to Ashland, OR for another two years of quilting life, and then last fall to Bainbridge Island, WA to her final days of quilting. We built the home in Bow Canyon in '72 and for over 30 years she lived there full time until 2012, the memories were fresh and joyful and sustaining in her final years. She died peacefully in her sleep and all I could think about is how much she loved Big B ear, her life with my father and her quilt guild.



#### "FINALLY FINISHED" 2016 UFO CHALLENGE

This year we are having a UFO challenge again. This is to give you a little motivation to get some of those UFO's FINALLY FINISHED!

There is a \$10 entry fee to play the game. All the entry fees will go into a jackpot and at the end, August of 2016, one lucky quilter will win the jackpot!

The game is a bit different this year. You need to do a little homework before you enter the challenge. You need to look through your UFO's and make a list of the UFO's you hope to complete, up to ten projects can be listed. I will have forms if you would like or a list from you will suffice. You need to list a basic description of each UFO project, basic size and color/pattern. Then when you complete a quilt and bring it to show, I will check it off of your list and give you an entry ticket.

They do not need to be done in any specific order and you do not need to complete them all. The minimum size to qualify is a crib/wall hanging size of 42" X 42".

Mom and Dad quilts do not qualify.

Doves quilts do not qualify.

Table runners do not qualify.

Each completed quilt earns an entry ticket and you can earn up to five entries. In August 2016 one ticket will be drawn and that quilter will win the jackpot. SO the more quilts you finish the more chances you'll have in the pot!

So look through your UFO's, make a list and let's get some quilts FINALLY FINISHED this year!

### STITCHING WITH LOVE

At our April meeting, we will explore some special handwork techniques that can be used to make memorable quilts.

Sue Bost and Gay Joyner will display their embroidered and crayon-tinted quilt masterpieces, and will share their hints for creating successful embellished projects.

Then Jill Gilham will introduce us to the legend of Promise Stitching, in preparation for our Tuesday workshop. This lovely relaxing handwork technique would be perfect to use on a very special memory quilt. You will be inspired to join us at the workshop!

And of course we always enjoy admiring each other's quilts, so our April meeting would be the perfect opportunity for you to share any crazy quilts or other types of hand-embellished quilts you've created, in addition to any other projects you've worked on recently.

At our Tuesday workshop, THE PROMISE, Jill will teach us the special steps involved in creating a Promise Quilt. This is strictly a hand-stitching technique, so you don't even need to bring a sewing machine – just some scraps and your hand sewing notions. The only special supply item needed is ½ yard of diaper flannel, available at Bear Country Quilts and Gifts.

A "tea party" luncheon is included in your \$20 workshop fee, and we have room for more participants, so please consider joining us. Remember that we need at least 5 attendees paid in advance in order to hold our workshops every month, so be sure to sign up soon and get your supply list!

# HOP \* SKIP \* JUMP BUSY BEARS SEW-ALONG 2016

Here's a VERY EASY lap-size quilt for you to make - perfect for yourself, for a gift, or for a Doves comfort quilt! We'll spend five months sewing along together, so pull out some awesome fabric and start creating. Be sure to bring your Step 4 blocks to the Guild meeting on Monday April 18 so we can admire them!

\*\*\*\*\*\*

Lap quilt – 52" x 72" 5 steps + finishing Style - simple piecing Skill level - very easy

#### **Fabric requirements:**

Fabric A background 2 2/3 yards Fabric B pattern 1 2/3 yards

Backing 3 1/4 yards Binding 1/2 yard

\*\*\*\*\*\*



#### STEP 4

Before you cut any additional pieces, take a look at the scraps you saved from last month's instructions and try to recycle them to complete this step. You may not need to cut as many new strips as the instructions call for.

Cutting: Fabric A 4 strips @ 2 1/2" x WOF, cut into 60 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Fabric B 5 strips @ 2 1/2" x WOF, cut into 75 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Sewing: Using a 1/4" seam, sew fifteen 9-patch blocks as follows:

B A BA B AB A B

NOTE: this color placement is opposite from the small blocks you sewed last month

Each unit will measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"







We're almost done - next month will be our final step! We will assemble the sub-units we've been sewing into bigger blocks and rows, and then complete our quilt tops.
