This month, Sylvia Davis will mix a wide variety of quilts with numerous quilting tips and ideas to inform and entertain us with her "Quirky Quilter's Alphabet" lecture.

"Do Not Touch" Mini-Quilt Challenge"

What's this...another challenge...and what is a "Do Not Touch" mini guilt anyway???

These small, 8X10" or 10X12" mini-quilts are woven in between the quilts hung in our quilt show. They are used to remind our guests that our quilts on display may be touched with "gloved hands" only.

We want to make our guests smile when they see them, and at the same time become aware of the protocol and courtesy that is expected.

Two examples are given below. I will also have samples at our next meeting to inspire you.

The basics of the DNT challenge are:

Have FUN and be CREATIVE in reminding our guest that the quilts on display may be touched with gloved hands only.

Think small...8X10" to 10X12" are the most desirable size

Bring your finished quilt to the August meeting for a show of hands judging. The winner will receive a check for \$25.

BUSY BEAR QUILT GUILD BOUTIQUE GUIDELINES

If you are entering crafts or hand-made items at the Busy Bear Quilt Show, there are a few guidelines to follow:

GENERAL

- 1. All items must be hand-crafted by guild members
- 2. If you are selling items in the boutique, it would be great if you would sign up to work a shift or two in the boutique area during the show
- 3. All items must be listed on the Busy Bears 2016 Boutique Form. It will be printed in the June, July and August newsletters. It will also be available to download from the Busy Bears website: www.busybearsquiltguild.com. This completed form must be submitted with your boutique items.

PREPARING THE BOUTIQUE FORM

- 1. List the items by number. Enter description, quantity and price
- 2. Enter multiples of the same item and price using one item number. Example: 5 birdhouses at \$40.00 each would be listed as Item #1, description-birdhouses, quantity 5 and price \$40 each.
- 3. Keep a copy of your boutique form for your personal use, as the original form will not be returned.

SUBMITTING ITEMS

- 1. Attach a removable string tag to each item. Make sure the tags are securely attached to each item. If necessary use a safety pin, tape or a sticky dot. Make sure each tag has Item #, your initials and price on one side.
- 2. Tags will be available at the July and August BBQG meetings.

Bring all items to the show site on the Friday before the show between 4:30 pm-6:00 pm. Please make sure your BBQG Boutique Form is complete. Please ensure all items are tagged properly, as it will make the check-in process go much faster. After all items have been checked in, the display process will take place.

PICKING UP ITEMS

Unsold items may be picked up Sunday after 4:30 pm. This process takes time as unsold items are inventoried and recorded on your boutique form, please be patient.


