Greetings! Hope to see you at both the meeting and the workshop this month.

September meeting will be the presentation of the "Viewer's Choice" Awards from the quilt show.

September workshop is going to be fun. Bonnie Marshall-Creel will be giving a class on Ice Dyeing. You can sign up for the workshop(\$20) and participate in the actual dyeing process. Bonnie will have a kit for you with everything you will need to do the dyeing process. The kit will contain gloves, dust mask, rubber bands, synthrapol (for washing the fabric), two fat quarters, plastic sheeting for manipulation, and use of the dyes. The cost of the kit is \$25. The only other things you would need is an ice chest with 10 pounds of ice and a plastic shoe box or similar. You can also just sign up for the workshop(\$20), watch the demonstration and take notes. At this point, if you think you will want a kit, you need to call Bonnie so she can get one together for you. If you would like more fabric, give Bonnie a call(818 919-1768)-she will order and bring it to the meeting already prepared. She does need to know well in advance to place the order.

October Meeting-Our speakers will be from Doves and the Mom and Dad Project. They will be sharing their programs with us and how our quilts assist the program.

October workshop will be a charity event. Details to follow. Shirley Hartwick will be leaving us and Sue Hart will be the new chairperson, so a little organizing is going on.
