### **General Meeting Minutes**

September 23, 2024

#### **I. Call to order**

President Lindy Edmond called to order the regular meeting of the Busy Bears Quilt Guild at 6:00 p.m. on September 23, 2024 at the Historical Chapel of Community Church, 40946 Big Bear Blvd., Big Bear Lake, Ca. Pledge of Allegiance led by Michele Parris.

#### **II. Approval of Minutes from last meeting**

The minutes of the August 19, 2023 General Meeting as published in the September 2024 newsletter were approved on a motion by Belinda Evans, second by Flo Snyder. The motion was carried and approved.

#### **III. Open Issues**

- a) **Treasurer Report** - Michele Rustigan reported on the Quilt Show receipts and expenses by categories of Entrance, Marketplace, Baskets, Opportunity Quilt, Wine, and Totals. A break down sheet was provided to all members. No reporting on the checking and savings accounts. No motions nor approvals were held.
- b) **Membership** - Jeanne Mazzacane reported 67 members for 2024. Lindy Edmond reported the Idea Box had one new idea and the Board will review the idea at the next Board meeting. The Guild welcomed 1 guest.
- c) **Sunshine and Shadows** - Theresa Georgi announced the birthdays for September. Members sang Happy Birthday to the members present.
- d) **Philanthropy** - Robin Davis shared that quilts are needed for Doves and Hospice. Robin has quilt kits ready and members will receive a ticket for the Christmas drawing as they complete charity quilts.
- e) **Publicity and Marketing** - Susie Oberneder had nothing to report.
- f) **2025 Opportunity Quilt** - Lys Axelson reported the quilt is done and ready to be shown. Still needs a label by Bonnie Snell.
- g) **2025 Fall Block Swap** - Lys Axelson will have at the next meeting. Hint: Celebrates 35 years of the Guild.
- h) **UFO Challenge** - Janice Stillwell reports that it is \$10 required to participate and due by October. Can enter as many items as you like for the one-time \$10. Winner takes all the money. Sign ups are at the front table. Thirteen people are participating so far.
- i) **2025 Challenge Quilt** - Lindy Edmond announced that Wendy Stephens and Robin Davis are chairing this challenge. Wendy reported that projects will be voted on at the July 2025 general meeting. Theme is "These boots are made for . . . ." and each participant will add the last word in this title for their individual project. Wendy said that 18 packets were taken for 2024 and 9 completed. Wendy gave kudos to the members who participated as many ribbons were awarded for this category at the Quilt Show.
- j) **Stitchy Fingers** - Sue Bost explained Stitchy Fingers and says the next Stitchy Fingers is this Friday, September 27, 10 a.m., at Theresa Georgi's home. Email will

go out to participants for the address. Contact Laurie Hancock to get on the email list. Stitchy Fingers is the second and fourth Friday of every month.

- k) **Middle School Sewing Camp** - Lindy Edmond reports the next committee meeting will be October 10, 11a.m., at Lindy's home, 1032 Heritage Trail, Big Bear City. Everyone is welcome to attend.
- l) **Special Events** - Suzie Oberneder reports the Christmas Party - December 2, 5 p.m. cocktails, dinner at 6 p.m., Santana Mavericks, \$25 - Guild pays remainder. Ornament exchange. Sign ups at the next meeting.
- m) **Ways and Means** - Elaine Dobiesz was absent. Janice Stillwell reported that the Tea Party in June, 2025 will be a no-host tea party. Elaine is asking for 6 centerpieces as she has plate services for all tables. Those contributing a centerpiece will not pay the \$25. Needed are kitchen and food service helpers. 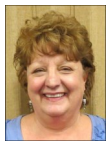
## **PROGRAMS**

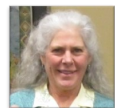

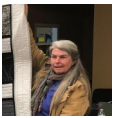

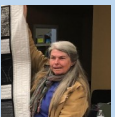

## **COMFORT QUILTS & TEDDY BEARS**

**Guidelines:** Please use the sign in and sign out sheets when taking or returning your project. **Do** a quick housekeeping on your project (loose threads, pet hair, etc.) **Remember** no "Made by" labels on projects. **All projects** to be turned in at monthly general meetings at Philanthropy table. **Do not** just leave items at Philanthropy table, **label** your bag that the item(s) are in to ensure you get credit for them. **If you** plan to enter something in the annual show your comfort quilt or bears must be received no later than August 1, 2024. **Quilt tops** are not accepted. **Tops** must be quilted and finished.

- **Bear Valley Hospice and Dove's** comfort quilts suggested size: 44" - 46" by 58" - 62". Kits are available. The BBQG provides batting and backing as well.
- **Moms & Dads** Project baby quilts suggested size: 36" by 36". Pre-cut kits available.
- **Seven Stars Foundation** provides quilts for children of military families, aged 5 - 17 who attend YMCA camps across the nation. Suggested size: Lap to twin. Fabric available.
- **Kids in Crisis** program makes teddy bears and bunnies for first responders to carry in their vehicles and hand out as needed when responding to emergencies. Patterns and fabric available.

You are always welcome to use your own fabrics and designs for these projects. Look forward to seeing your creations.



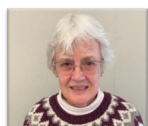
